This comprehensive study of a 20 hectare brownfield site, was completed from April 2002 to June 2003 for 22 & 66 Mohawk Street and 347 Greenwich Street in the City of Brantford. The purpose of this study was to evaluate the environmental status of the site, assess the existing condition of the site buildings and to develop a strategy to guide redevelopment.

As part of the community building process The Brownfield Review provided the detailed study findings in an understandable format, while facilitating the submission of comments on the technical findings and to guide the redevelopment strategies.
